### 1. God is always at work around you.

- God where are you at work in my life? My family?

- Where are you at work in our community, city, nation, and world?

### 2. God pursues a continuing love relationship with you that is real and personal.

- Draw us as a church more closely to you in a vital on-going personal relationship.
- May we be passionate in our devotion to you.

### 3. God invites you to become involved with him in his work.

- How can I join you in your activity in my life? My family?
- How can IBCB join you in your activity in our life as a church?
- In our relationships? In our community? In our world?

### 4. God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal himself, his purposes, and his ways.

- Open my ears that I may hear you speak.
- Speak to us through the Word taught and preached.
- Speak to us in times of prayer.
- What are you saying to us through the circumstances around us?
- Open our hearts to a fresh revelation of yourself.
- Show us your purposes and your ways.

### 5. God's invitation for you to work with him always leads you to a crisis of belief that requires faith and action.

- Help my unbelief. Help our unbelief as a church.
- Strengthen our faith as a congregation.
- Reveal to me and to us what action best demonstrates our faith?
- What action should we take as a church to demonstrate our faith in you?

### 6. You must make major adjustments in your life to join God in what he is doing.

- What adjustments do I need to make in my character, my relationships, in my home, in my place of work?
- What adjustments does our church need to make in our attitude, in our actions, in our schedule, in our ministry?
- Give me/us the courage to make the necessary adjustments to be about your kingdom business.

### 7. You come to know God by experience as you obey him and he accomplishes his work through you.

- I want to know you more. I want to obey you.
- May we as a church come to know you by experience as we obey you.
- Accomplish your work through us.
