
How Can God Accept Us?

Sacrifice (Personal Offering)

Jesus' Death

Reconciliation (Relational)

"For if, when we were God's enemies, we were **reconciled** to him through **the death of his Son**, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved **through his life!**" **Romans 5:10** (NIV)

Justification (Legal)

Redemption (Payment)


"...and are justified freely by his grace through the **redemption** that came by Christ Jesus." **Romans 3:24 (NIV)**



Jesus' Resurrection

Victory (Overcome)

"...Christ Jesus...has **destroyed death** and has **brought life** and immortality to light through the gospel." **2 Timothy 1:9-10 (NIV)**

- God's "yes" to the life and death of Jesus.
- Demonstrated Jesus' victory over sin and death.
- Jesus is alive and offers his life to all who turn to him in faith.

Jesus' Resurrection

- We receive the righteousness of Christ.
- We live a resurrection life through the power of the risen Christ.
