

The Testimony Triangle

Think of your testimony as a “three-tiered triangle” with the top being “My life before Christ,” the middle tier being “How I came to know Christ,” and the base “My life since I met Christ.” Spend the shortest amount of time on the “top section” and present the “middle section” with more detail. Give the most time to the “base section” since that is what is most important—how knowing Jesus has made a difference.

The diagram is a visual depiction of the amount of time given to the three primary parts of a personal testimony. The least amount of time is given to “before Christ” and the most time is given to “since Christ.”
